2024-2025 TEACHER IMPACT GRANTS

Application Guidelines

DEADLINES:

JUN 30, 2024	Grant Applications Due
APR 30, 2025	All projects must be completed
MAY 15, 2025	Submit Grant Recipient Evaluation Report

- Classroom Impact Grant: Requests of up to \$750 will be accepted.
Dr. Murry Impact Grant: Requests must be greater than \$750 with a maximum of \$2500 will be accepted.
- Projects must directly involve students, demonstrate sound educational values, have clear, well-defined goals, and represent the applicant's original thoughts.
- Grants must be submitted via CPSD Google Forms. Well-written grants that demonstrate creativity, innovation, and hands-on learning will be given preference.
- Grants may be used to purchase equipment, instructional materials or to provide field trip transportation per grant cycle if these are components of a larger "focus" project.
- Any tangible items purchased become the property of the Conway Public School District.
- Teachers and teams may now apply for both the Classroom Impact Grant and the Dr. Murry Impact Grant, however only one will be awarded. No funds will be awarded for duplicate grants.
- The projected budget must include an itemized list of purchases by category.
Example: You may list "classroom books" - you don't have to list each individual title.
- Grants for technology are eligible for funding, if these are components of a larger "focus" project. All technology equipment including software must be pre-approved by Joel Dean before submission to ensure system compatibility.
- Grant money may not be used to pay for substitute teachers.
- Grant Evaluation Reports must be completed. Failure to do so will automatically exclude the recipient from future grant cycles.
